In this archway during the 1800s a change of horses from the Bianconi stables at the rear awaited the daily arrival of the Waterford and Carlow two horse four wheeled Bianconi cars.

During the 1700s in River Lane diagonally across from the entrance to Duiske Abbey, a club and entertainment centre was run by a committee of leading citizens. The abduction in 1779 of the Kennedy sisters lead to the execution of three young men, the last hanging for such a crime to take place in Ireland.

created by Mary Burtchaell of Brandondale circa 1850. There are fifty-four sketches, many of them showing Graiguenamanagh and its surrounding areas. The original book of sketches are on display in Graig library kindly loaned by Graiguenamanagh Historical Society.

Cistercian Monks Graiguenamanagh **Booklet**



A project of the Graiguenamanagh Tidy Towns committee in 2004 to mark the 800th anniversary of Duiske Abbey let to a total of 12 monks erected around the town to highlight the history of the Abbey and to celebrate the effort of local people in more recent times to keep this heritage alive.


