Kilkenny Library Internet Policy

- 1. Users are entitled to two sessions per day. Further sessions are subject to the availability of PC's , with the consent of library staff.
- 2. A normal session is 45 minutes in duration.
- 3. Only one person per PC.
- 4. Bookings which are not taken up within 10 minutes will be forfeited.
- 5. Users may use their own disks, USBs and CDs in the PCs.
- 6. There is a charge for printouts, see or ask in branch for details.
- 7. Children under 18 yrs may use the Internet, provided that the Guarantor section of the Library membership application form is signed by parent/ guardian at registration or renewal. Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children's internet usage
- 8. Children under 12 years using the Internet must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult
- 9. This is a self-help facility, users must be able to use a computer or be accompanied by someone who can.
- 10. Users may not create, access, copy, store, transmit, download or publish any material which: is obscene, racist, defamatory or illegal; causes harassment or gross offence to others and/or constitutes a breach of copyright laws or licensing agreements. Unintentional opening of such material must be reported to Library Staff immediately by the user who opened it.
- 11. Filter software is installed on all PCs and Library staff monitor usage at all times.
- 12. Kilkenny County Library Service is not responsible for any information found on the Internet. Individuals use the information at their own discretion.
- 13. Users who fail to observe the above conditions will immediately be logged out and denied access to Internet facilities.
